Why this Guide Exists

There are a total of 41 issues in the Tiny Thomists program. Each was designed to teach a particular aspect about the Catholic faith as taught to us by St. Thomas Aquinas in his Summa Theologica. With so many published issues, it can be hard to locate the lesson that is just right for your kiddo. Sometimes, they might be struggling with obedience (Issue 2) or perhaps they have questions about heaven and hell (Issue 25). This guide was designed to help you locate the issue you need to teach your child the specific Catholic truth they need at the moment they need it.

It is important to note that the absolute best way to use the Tiny Thomists program is to go through it chronologically starting with Issue 1. There are some lessons that build on each other.

That being said, it is also very possible to pick and choose each lesson depending on the needs of your child. Knowing information from previous issues is the ideal, but it is not necessary as each issue has been designed to stand alone if needed.

How to Use this Guide

In any browser or PDF reader, you have the option to search for words. For MAC users, all you need to do is push "Command" and "F" to open up the search bar. For Windows users, it is "Ctrl" and "F". Once you have the search box open, enter in a key word for the topic you are looking for. Then, click the "Find" button and this document will have every mention of that word highlighted.

For example: If my child asks me, "Daddy, what is heaven like?" I can search for the word "heaven" and my document will highlight the word "heaven" found in issues 5 and 25, both which mention that theme as a key concept.

I can then return back to <u>dominicaninstitute.com/ttmembers</u> and find those issues, download them, and immediately start teaching my kids about those themes.
